


# **EMPLOYMENT PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION**


# REVENUE PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION

Moscow is a centre of national filming industry. According to the expert community, over 90% of films are made here, and 80% of animation studios are located in the capital. It is also leading among other Russian cities by the number of movie theatres and cinema halls.

Nine companies from Moscow and two from St Petersburg have entered the rating for the number of awards and wins at the largest Russian film festivals. The number of award-winning pictures varies from two ('Vertical' and 'SAGa Film Company') to nine ('CTB Film Company'). 177 films won in at least one nomination, of which 25 were awarded prizes in two and more events.

In 2015–2019, 713 Russian films have been released in Russian cinemas (28% of all released films). By the number of releases among distributors, the leader is 'Mult v kino', which produces collections of premiering animation series of the same name. The highest box office was secured by 'Central Partnership', 'Karoprokat', and 'Walt Disney Studios Sony Pictures Releasing': they hold 65% of the aggregate ticket-selling revenues.



Moscow- and St Petersburg-based studios are leading by the number of wins at Russian animation festivals and received awards during 2017–2019. 'Soyuzmultfilm' tops the rating with 29 awards under its belt, followed by 'Petersburg Animation Studio' (23 awards) and a Moscow studio 'Parovoz'. 127 animation projects have won in at least one nomination, of which 25 have been awarded on two and more occasions.

For the last ten years Russian studios have been actively launching YouTube channels for their animation series. The leader by the number of views and subscribers is 'Masha and the Bear' show for children (Animaccord). There are over 800 episodes with over 25 billion views.

Russian cartoons have gained popularity abroad. Thus, the English-language channel of 'Masha and the Bear' has almost 500 episodes, which cumulative audience has reached 8.5 billion views. The biggest number of episodes in English are represented on the channel streaming 'The Fixies' (Aeroplan Studio).
