






EMPLOYMENT PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION


REVENUE PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION





Moscow publishers, 'Prosveshcheniye Publishers' and 'Eksmo', as well as 'AST Publishing Group', have accounted for over 40% of the total print run of printed books in Russia and almost 20% of publications made in 2019.

In 2019, the volume of Russian book market was estimated at 60.66 billion roubles (excluding unstructured sales and purchases of publications by budget organisations).

Main distribution channel – retail trade (over 75%), including bookstores, chain book stalls, and non-book retail trade. 23.2% of the market falls for online shopping, its share in the overall turnover grows annually. The 2018-2019 growth rate reached 3 pp.
